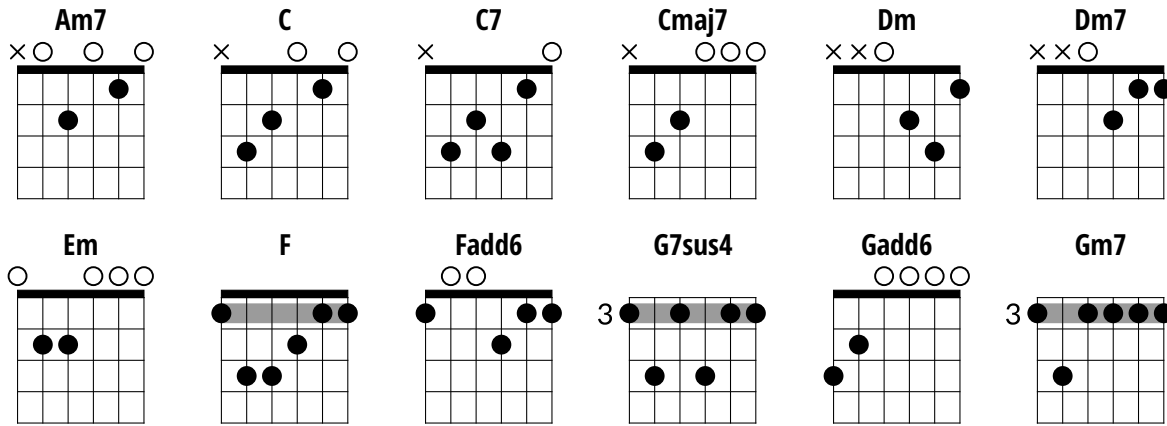


Dear Rosemary
